## CRISIS INTERVENTION

FavorHouse shelters and crisis lines are staffed 24 hours a day, year round. Victims, their families and those who are assisting them may call for help at any time.

## ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for safe shelter, a person must be:

- A victim of domestic violence by an intimate partner
- A victim of sexual abuse

When coming to the residence, we recommend that you bring the following items, if possible:

- Identification documents
- Health Insurance cards
- Children's birth certificates
- Several changes of clothes but not more than one bag per person
